

THE FEAST OF CORPUS CHRISTI (the Body and Blood of Christ) Sunday 2 June

"Love transforms all things, and therefore it is understood that at the very heart of today's feast of Corpus Christi there is the mystery of transubstantiation, the sign of Christ-Love that transforms the world. Looking at Him and adoring Him we say: yes, love exists, and because it exists things can change for the better and we can hope." Pope Benedict XVI, Angelus 2009

At all the Masses this Sunday, the parish Ministers of Holy Communion will renew their commitment to serve our community by helping Fr Martin to administer Holy Communion especially at Sunday Mass and bring Holy Communion to the sick and housebound. We thank God for the ministry of these men and women.

Also at these Masses on this Feast, those who wish to do so will be able to receive Holy Communion under both kinds, that is, to receive the Body of Christ and His Precious Blood.

If you have a cold or any other potentially infectious ailment, you should refrain from receiving the Precious Blood from the chalice.

We are blessed to have Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament on a Friday morning 9.30 a.m. -1.00 p.m. and evening 7.00-8.00p.m.. All are welcome to come into the Lord's presence and to spend time with Him in contemplative adoration.

This Feast also provides an opportunity to reflect on the Tabernacle, the house of the Living God. Is its present position prominent and visible? Does the Blessed Sacrament chapel attract people to spend time before our Lord in quiet prayer and adoration? Might there be any spiritual value in considering a more central and conspicuous place for the Tabernacle, for example, on the original high altar which is no longer in use? By doing so, might this make clearer that Christ is the centre and focus of all that we are and do as a community?

NEW LECTIONARIES FOR THE CHURCH From the First Sunday of Advent this year, a new translation of all the readings will be introduced in England and Wales. This means that we will have to purchase four volumes of the new lectionary that cover

I: Sundays, Solemnities, Feasts of the Lord.

II: Weekdays: Advent, Christmas, Ordinary Time (weeks 1-9), Lent, Easter. Proper of Saints: December - June, Commons.

III: Weekdays: Ordinary Time (6-34). Proper of Saints: June -November, Commons.

IV: Ritual Masses, Masses for Various Needs and Occasions, Votive Masses, Masses for the Dead.

We will also purchase a Book of the Gospels to be used in solemn procession.
