SOLEMNITY OF ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY (a Holy Day of Obligation) is on Thursday 15th August. Vigil Mass on Wednesday 14th at 7.00 p.m and Mass on Thursday 15th at 9.00 a.m. Pope Francis writes:

“Mary says: “My souls glorifies the Lord” - today, the Church too sings this in every part of the world. This song is particularly strong in places where the Body of Christ is suffering the Passion. For us Christians, wherever the Cross is, there is hope, always. If there is no hope, we are not Christian...do not allow yourselves to be robbed of hope. May we not be robbed of hope, because this strength is a grace, a gift from God which carries us forward with our eyes fixed on heaven. And Mary is always there, near those communities, our brothers and sisters, she accompanies them, suffers with them, and sings the *Magnificat* of hope with them.”

PREPARING TO SAY FAREWELL TO THE SISTERS OF MERCY In 1917, the Sisters of Mercy set up a community in Cambridge Park, Wanstead. Over a century later, the present community are preparing to leave us as they move to Brentwood.

It is with a real sense of sadness and a deeper sense of gratitude that we thank the Sisters Of Mercy for their spiritual presence and religious witness. Their prayer has provided our parish community with its beating heart. But we also thank them for the pastoral care of countless numbers of parishioners over all these years. So much of this work was unseen and largely uncommented upon, but all of it gave glory to God and was of eternal value.

If you wish to have your child baptised, please phone the parish office and register for the next two formation sessions. You will be asked to confirm that, at least, one parent is a Catholic and that you are living in the parish. Parents must attend both formation sessions. This formation is for parents of babies, including those not yet born. If your child is 7 or over, they will have to be prepared in an alternative, age appropriate way.

The next formation sessions will be held in the Pastoral Centre on Thursday evenings: *5th and 12th September*. Registration is from 7.45 p.m. with an 8.00 p.m. start.
