

NEW LECTIONARY FOR READINGS AT MASS From the First Sunday of Advent all Catholic churches in this country will use a new translation of the Bible (the English Standard Version). Therefore, there will be new missals available as you come into Mass. You may wish to buy your own copy and they will be available from the Church shop £10 or online www.ctsbooks.org ³ We thank those generous donors (the Nunes family, the Burns family and Michael Smith) who purchased lectionaries and a Book of the Gospels for use in the sanctuary.

ADVENT What does the word mean? The Latin word "adventus" can be translated as "presence" or "arrival". Originally it was used as a technical term for the arrival of a high official and especially for the arrival of kings. It also had a theological sense that expressed the arrival of a god who emerged from darkness and hiddenness.

Christians adopted this word in order to express their special relationship to Jesus Christ. Jesus is the King of the universe who through His Incarnation, the taking of our human flesh, revealed Himself by entering the earthly realm we inhabit.

When Christians use the word "advent", they intend to say: God is not a rumour. He is here. He has not withdrawn from the world or left us alone. God is not one thing or object among the many things and objects in the universe. God is the reason, the Word, that has brought all these things into being and gives them ultimate meaning. We celebrate God's first coming to us in the person of Jesus and we now wait for the return of the King.

HOLY COMMUNION UNDER BOTH KINDS will be reintroduced on the First Sunday of Advent. Those who wish to do so will be able to receive both the Body of Christ and His Precious Blood. It is a wonderful gift for the Church to have the faithful receive the Precious Blood at Mass.

The Church clearly teaches that the entire Christ is fully present, Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity within each Eucharistic species, that is, within the consecrated bread and the wine.

Please remember that Covid-19 and other infections remain present in our community. While any risks of transmission are probably low, if you are clinically vulnerable, or have a weakened immune system, you and any other member of the community are free to choose not to receive the Precious Blood.
