

"The kingship of Jesus is completely different than that of the world. "My kingship", he says to Pilate, "is not of this world" (*Jn 18:36*). He did not come to dominate but to serve. He did not come amid signs of power, but with the power of signs. He was not dressed with precious insignia, but he was naked on the cross. And it was precisely through the inscription placed on the cross that Jesus came to be defined as "king" (cf. *Jn* 19:19). His kingship is truly beyond human parameters! We could say that he is not *like other kings*, but he is a *King for others*."
