JOURNEY IN FAITH Have you been worshiping with us, but never taken the step to become Catholic? Have you drifted away from the Church, and have now returned, but want to know more? Are you a baptised Catholic, but never received the Sacraments of Confirmation and/or Eucharist? Have you joined us from a different religious background or no religious background and would like to find out more about Jesus and His Church?

If you (or someone you know) answers "Yes" to any of these questions, you are invited to find out more through a process called the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) or the Journey in Faith.

HOLY COMMUNION UNDER BOTH KINDS was reintroduced on the First Sunday of Advent. Those who wish to do so can now receive both the Body of Christ and His Precious Blood. It is a wonderful gift to have the faithful be able to receive the Precious Blood at Sunday Mass.

The Church clearly teaches that the entire Christ is fully present, Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity within each Eucharistic species, that is, within the consecrated bread and the wine.

Please remember that Covid-19 and other infections remain present in our community. While any risks of transmission are probably low, if you are clinically vulnerable, or have a weakened immune system, you and any other member of the community are free to choose not to receive the Precious Blood.

Please note that intinction, the dipping of the Body of Christ into the chalice with His Precious Blood, is not permitted in this country. This is because the Bishops of England and Wales are concerned that the consecrated host may drip the Precious Blood and that we are called to observe that the Lord's command is to "drink" His blood and not simply "receive" it. This is better and more fully expressed by receiving directly from the chalice.
