

COVER IMAGE: The Feast of the Presentation of the Lord (Candlemas) is on Sunday 2nd February.

According to Jewish law, the firstborn male child belonged to God, and the parents had to "buy him back" on the fortieth day after his birth by offering a sacrifice of "a pair of turtledoves, or two young pigeons" (Luke 2:24) in the temple.

When Christ was presented in the Temple, "there was a man in Jerusalem named Simeon, and this man was just and devout,"

(Luke 2:25) Simeon embraced the Christ child and prayed these words (the *Nunc Dimitis* that is prayed ever night in the prayer of the Church):

"Lord, now you are letting your servant depart in peace, according to your word; for my eyes have seen your salvation that you have prepared in the presence of all peoples, a light for the revelation to the Gentiles, and for glory to your people Israel."

**THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM** marks the beginning of a child's relationship with Christ. This is also an opportunity for parents to thank God for the gift of their child and to strengthen or re-kindle their own relationship with Christ by the practice of their faith, by participating in the celebration of Sunday Mass.

If you wish to have your child baptised, please phone the parish office and register for the next two formation sessions. You will be asked to confirm that, at least, one parent is a Catholic and that you are living in the parish and will be asked to provide your address to confirm this. Parents must attend both formation sessions. This formation is for parents of babies, including those not yet born. If your child is 7 or over, they will have to be prepared in an alternative, age appropriate way.

**ADORATION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT** will take place on Fridays from 9.30 a.m. -1.00 p.m. and 7.00 - 8.00 p.m. and will recommence on 10th January 2025.
