ACN supports over 5,000 projects helping the Church's mission internationally. ACN has stepped up its support for Christians in Lebanon, Syria and Holy Land in response to the deepening crisis offering food, medicine, help with education, pastoral programmes and other desperately-needed assistance. This year, ACN is also focusing on the suffering of young Christians in priority countries, many of whom are orphaned and displaced due to targeted attacks against their Christian communities. There will be a retiring collection after all Masses.

ASH WEDNESDAY is on the 5th of March and marks the beginning of the forty days of Lent, a time of spiritual preparation fas individuals and a community for the Easter Vigil. Mass times with imposition of ashes will be at 9.15 a.m. and 7.00 p.m.

Please note that there will be no evening Adoration of Blessed Sacrament during Lent.

WHAT HAPPENED TO THE FINAL HYMN AT SUNDAY MASS? Lent is forty days of more serious and disciplined preparation for the celebration of the Death and Resurrection of Jesus. It is for this reason that our worship is more restrained: we do not sing the joyful Gloria, there are no flowers on the sanctuary and we will not sing a final hymn. This restraint focuses our attention on our relationship with God and a deepening of faithfulness to that relationship.

THE SUNDAY EVENING MASS TIME will be changed to the earlier time of 5.00 p.m. from the First Sunday of Lent, 9th March. Fr Martin would like to thank the Parish Council and those parishioners who expressed a view. These all helped to inform his decision on this matter.

All other Sunday Mass times will remain as they are at present.
