The fourth Sunday of Easter is Good Shepherd Sunday and the World Day of Prayer for Vocations

The fundamental vocation is the call to be baptised. To be baptised is to accept Christ's call to follow him in a new way of life. Our primary vocation is to love Jesus. This involves loving attention to the needs of others and to Christ, strengthened by the Holy Spirit and living as an active member of the Body of Christ, the Church. The root meaning of vocation is calling and the first calling shared by all Christians is the call to know and love Jesus.

"God has created me to do him some definite service." Saint John Henry Newman

Once a person takes seriously their personal call to holiness, then the other dimensions of Christian vocation are opened up.

There are five basic states of life within the Catholic Church: marriage, consecrated life, priesthood, the permanent diaconate and the single state as a lay person. Each one of these is both fulfilling and demanding and people need help to discern which of these Christ is calling them to.

Every person has a personal vocation. Discerning what that vocation is the key to understanding who we are and our purpose in life. If you wish to consider what definite service the Lord may have in mind for you go to:
