FORMATION FOR HOLY COMMUNION 2025 -26 There will be a preliminary parents meeting in the Pastoral Centre on Saturday 5th July from 9.00-10.00 a.m. for parents interested in their child joining the programme. It is important that parents attend this meeting. To enrol for this formation:

- i) Your child must be resident in Our Lady of Lourdes parish
- ii) Your child must be going in to Year 4 in September 2025

THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM marks the beginning of a child's relationship with Christ. This is also an opportunity for parents to thank God for the gift of their child and to strengthen or rekindle their own relationship with Christ by the practice of their own faith, that is, by participating in the celebration of Sunday Mass. Only in this way do they become "the first and best teachers of the faith" by what they say and do.
