Why return the tabernacle to the centre of our Church?

Last year, Fr Martin asked parishioners for their views about returning the tabernacle to its original position in the centre of the church. He thanks all those who shared their views by email, post or in conversation. He also asked the views of the Parish Council and is grateful to them for their insights and guidance. These views have informed his decision to make arrangements for the tabernacle to be reinstated on the old High Altar.

The tabernacle is not just a piece of ecclesiastical furniture which can be placed anywhere. It is the house of the living God which should be in a prominent place where it is easily visible and before which people can pray and spend time in adoration whenever they want.

In the wake of Vatican II, many churches relocated their tabernacles either to the side of sanctuaries or to their own side chapels. The aim was to create a separate and conducive space where people would naturally gravitate to in order to pray and adore Christ's real presence in the reserved sacrament.

Beginning in the 1980's, there was a shift in the guidance given by the Holy See on this issue. For example, the 1980 *Instruction on the Worship of the Eucharist* stated, "The tabernacle in which the Eucharist is kept can be located on an altar, or away from it, in a place in the church which is *very prominent*, *truly noble and duly decorated*, or in a chapel suitable for private prayer and for adoration by the faithful."

These clarifications were, in part, a response to concerns that many Catholics have lost an awareness of the Eucharistic presence of Christ in the tabernacle and an appreciation of the Eucharistic mystery, in general.

By returning the tabernacle to the centre of our church, in plain sight of all, we reaffirm the centrality of the Eucharist in our lives and the life of our parish community. In turn, this will help foster reverence and awe at the mystery of Christ's living presence in our midst. The tabernacle's visibility shows that Christ is the beating sacred heart of our community and that everything we do should flow from His divine life of love.

Therefore, before you give his name as a referee, please make an appointment to meet with Fr Martin to discuss the position you are applying for and the nature of the reference required. THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM marks the beginning of a child's relationship with Christ. This is also an opportunity for parents to thank God for the gift of their child and to strengthen or rekindle their own relationship with Christ by the practice of their own faith, that is, by participating in the celebration of Sunday Mass. Only in this way do they become "the first and best teachers of faith" by what they say and do.
