A SCHOOL CERTIFICATE OF CATHOLIC PRACTICE is required by parents applying to most Catholic Primary or Secondary schools. If you are a practicing Catholic (that is, coming to Sunday Mass here at Our Lady of Lourdes and known to Fr Martin) please collect a Certificate of Catholic Practice from Fr Martin on

Fr Martin will not give out Certificates at any other time.

**PLEASE NOTE** that Our Lady of Lourdes Primary School does not require a Certificate of Catholic Practice.

Also note that If you are applying to Davenant school, you need evidence that you have been practising your faith for six years. Fr Martin is not in a position to provide this information. However, Davenant has indicated that "if you have a Sidesman, Church Warden or lay person who holds a role, they can also act as a referee." Therefore, you should approach someone who has an active role in the parish community and who can vouch for your attendance at Sunday Mass and confirm this with the school.

Should a parent wish to make an appeal to a non-Catholic school, Fr Martin will not be able to support this appeal.
