ADVENT These coming weeks before Christmas are a time of shopping, eating and drinking. These very human ways of celebrating Christmas remind us that in Jesus, God took human flesh and that he really did come into the material reality of our human lives. But human beings are not just matter, we are spirit, as well. We are body and soul.

Advent is an opportunity for us to prepare spiritually to celebrate Christ's birth but also to prepare ourselves when he will come again. St Cyril of Jerusalem reminds us of this double meaning of Advent:

We do not preach only one coming of Christ, but a second as well, much more glorious than the first. The first coming was marked by patience; the second will bring the crown of divine kingdom.

At the first coming he was wrapped in swaddling clothes in a manger. At his second coming he will be clothed in light as in a garment. In the first coming he endured the cross, despising the shame; in the second coming he will be in glory, escorted by an army of angels.
